Subject: Notification of the completion of the written procedure for a decision of the Management Board to adopt the report on the technical functioning of the Central SIS II in 2017-2018

Pursuant to Article 50(4) of the regulation (EC) No 1987/2006 ("SIS II Regulation") and Article 66(4) of the Council Decision 2007/533/JHA ("SIS II Decision"), two years after SIS II is brought into operation and every two years thereafter the Management Authority (eu-LISA) shall submit to the European Parliament and the Council a report on the technical functioning of the Central SIS II and the Communication Infrastructure, including the security thereof, and the bilateral and multilateral exchange of supplementary information between Member States.

On 17 October 2019 the draft report on the technical functioning of the Central SIS II in 2017-2018 (document 2019-250), was sent for the decision of the Management Board via written procedure. By the deadline of the written procedure on 22 October 2019, no objections were received from the members with the right to vote.

Considering the above, and in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of the Agency's Rules of Procedure, the Management Board decides to adopt the following decision by written procedure:

The Management Board decides to adopt the report as stated in document 2019-250 on the technical functioning of the Central SIS II and the Communication Infrastructure, including the security thereof, and the bilateral and multilateral exchange of supplementary information between Member States pursuant to Article 50(4) of Regulation (EC) No 1987/2006 and Article 66(4) of Council Decision 2007/533/JHA.

The Management Board asks the Agency to submit the report to the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission pursuant to the above legal base and to publish it on eu-LISA's website.
